### ELitE (Early Literacy Enrichment) Program

 ELitE is an after school reading program designed to enhance early literacy skills, specifically tailored for BIPOC children and multilingual learners.

The overarching goal of the ElitE Program is to provide additional support to students, facilitating their progress towards achieving a third-grade reading level by the time they reach the end of the third grade school year. Research suggests that reading at the third grade level by the end of the school year is a strong predictor of high school graduation.

#### **Book Vending Machines + Books**

Empowers education through student ownership of books. Three of our lowest resourced schools are in need of a BVM. Students earn tokens to purchase their own books by exhibiting positive behavior and character traits, and then place their token in the BVM and select a book to keep. Funding will also help secure book inventory to keep up with the high inventory demand of the BVM's. Students are eager to earn as many books as they can!
